- 5. All Indian liquor and Foreign liquor sold under this license shall be duty paid and obtained from the Andhra Pradesh Beverages Corporation Limited.

- 6. The licensee shall maintain and furnish to the Excise Superintendent statistics showing the consumption of all kinds of liquors separately.
- 7. This licence is not transferable.
- 8. The licence shall be object to cancellation or suspension at will by the Commissioner of Prohibition and Excise.
