**ORDER:**

The Tribal Welfare Department have stated that, the Commissioner of Tribal Welfare, A.P., Hyderabad has submitted proposals for sanction of 2151 posts of Teachers in various categories in Tribal Welfare Ashram Schools which are upgraded from Primary Schools to High Schools. Further the Commissioner of Tribal Welfare has stated that as per the orders issued in G.O. 1<sup>st</sup> read above, detailed exercise has been done in respect of the Upper Primary Schools and High Schools in Tribal Welfare Department, taking into consideration the strength of students and number of posts required in each category and that based on such an exercise, 2151 additional posts of teachers are required in the Tribal Welfare Department. She has also stated that education related indicators like literacy, dropout ratio etc. status of tribals are much poorer in tribal areas as compared to plain areas and hence, there is urgent need to sanction these posts so as to ensure quality education to Tribal children.

2. After careful examination of the proposals submitted by the Commissioner of Tribal Welfare, Government hereby accord sanction for creation of following (2151) posts of Teachers in various categories in Tribal Welfare Ashram Schools under Tribal Welfare Department:
